Spelling/Phonics

This week in spelling we focused on Spl-, Scr-, Strand Spr- words. Ask your child what are some words that fit these spelling patterns. Also you can practice writing spelling words in a sentence to help your child develop a better understanding of his/her spelling words. We continued this week with sorting our words and finding what words were nouns and what words were verbs. Spelling City has been a great extension resource for the students to continue to grow in their spelling. Workshops/Grammar

We read together and worked hard on Lit Circles this week. We also practiced spelling with shaping words and writing our words forwards and backwards. We worked on locating books in RAZ Kids and completing an extension assignment—what we will be asked to do from now on as 'Chromebook' time in Workstraps. WoserseBatches and worked on some comprehension and story structure responses.
